Rules for Individual Kata

All students must be graded a Mon Grade up to 1st Kyu (Brown 2 White Stripes) and be able to confidently perform their current grade Kata i.e.
White, Red & Orange Belts - Heian Shodan
Yellow Belts - Heian Shodan and Heian Nidan
Green Belts - Heian Shodan, Nidan and Sandan
Purple Belts - Heian Shodan, Nidan, Sandan & Yondan
Purple & White Belts - Heian Shodan, Nidan, Sandan, Yondan & Godan
Brown Belts & Above - Heian Kata 1-5 & Tekki Shodan

Kohaku System / Knock-Out (Flag)

Heian Kata 1-5 Tekki Shodan

Please note that Kohaku System will be used all the way to the final, and no Tokui Kata's will be performed. The two losing contestants in the Semi-Final, will perform again for the Bronze position.

Rules for Individual Kumite

- 1) All students must be either a Mon Grade (Tigers) or graded 9th Kyu – 1st Kyu (No Black Belts). Kyu Graded students who have competed at International Tournaments are able to compete.
- 2) Tiger's Kumite will comprise of "Tag" Kumite (Pulling a tag from the oppositions belt)
- 3) Students aged up to 10-11 years (Purple & White Belt) will be "Tap" Kumite – Tapping your opponent on the shoulder to be awarded a point – control must be exercised at all times.
- 4) Students aged 10-11 Years (Brown & White Belt +) and students aged 12 years + Jiyu Kumite - Shobu Ippon rules.
- 5) SKIF-GB Approved mitts must be worn for all Jiyu Kumite Events (Red or White mitts can be worn)
- 6) Gumshield is compulsory for all students aged 10 Years +. Allowed protective equipment is a box and Females may wear chest protectors. All other protection to be cleared by the chief referee.
- 7) No Jodan (Head) for students aged 10-11 years.
- 8) Dangerous techniques are not permitted. These include axe kicks and spinning techniques whereby no control or focus can be applied.
- 9) No spectacles, jewellery, false teeth, or unrestrained long hair.
- 10) Clean white Gi's to be worn with sleeves and trouser bottoms rolled down. Sleeves must be no longer than your wrist bone, and Trouser Bottoms must be above the anklebone.
- 11) The scoring is 1 minute Shobu Ippon (2 Wazari / 1 Ippon) for Juniors, and 90 seconds for Seniors (16 Years +)
- 12) Jogai defined as any part of the foot over the line. First jogai is a warning, second is wazari, third will lose the match irrespective of Shobu Ippon or Ippon-Han
- 13) Encho sen (a further 30 – Junior / 45 - Senior seconds because of a drawn fight) – both competitors scores to carry over (including jogai's)
- 14) Sai Encho Sen (30 – Junior / 45 - Senior seconds with clean score sheet) if still drawn judges to give definite decision.
- 15) There needs to be 4 competitors per event for it to run.
